Some of the providers offer lessons, lead pony rides and pony camps. There is something for everyone and every experience level.

Camp Cobark

All the horses at Camp Cobark are bred in the bush, you will be guided and cared for by genuine bush stockmen. Have no doubt, you'll receive an authentic experience! Riders inhabit the essence of the true pioneering spirit as they learn about Australia's history.

Riding instruction is given before the start of your ride, so you don't have to be experienced to enjoy the thrill of the bush. Beginners are provided a suitable mount to match their capabilities.

Catering to all levels of riding ability, from total beginners to experienced riders, special needs and large riders (max weight 140kg) all are welcome.

All riders must wear;

- Long pants
- Enclosed shoes
- Helmets (provided by Camp Cobark)
- Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your ride for a compulsory safety demonstration.

Pony Camp

\$450 - Every school holidays Camp Cobark runs a Pony Camp. The camps are usually 5 to 6 days in duration and are ideal for kids 8 - 17 years.

Each child is provided a horse for the duration of the camp and will learn a range of riding skills, as well as the responsibility of caring for a horse. Activities include; trail riding, mustering, jumping, flatwork and bareback riding. The cost includes accommodation, meals and horse for the duration of the camp.
